## Why is FSBP 2020 important?

Quality unaccompanied housing is essential in preserving and enhancing the All-Volunteer Force. Leaders at all levels are obliged to ensure single Soldiers are housed in clean, safe, functional, and secure barracks, which reinforces our commitment to provide a quality of life commensurate with their service and sacrifice to the nation. A proper living environment includes privacy, comfort, and predictable living standards.



FSBP 2020 actively engages all stakeholders to improve the well-being and quality of life of unaccompanied single Soldiers.

## FSBP 2020 has 3 basic principles:

**Support the Mission:** Provide Senior Commanders flexibility to ensure single Soldiers are afforded world-class living arrangements

**Take care of Soldiers:** Provide quality accommodations and furnishings. Minimize changes to Soldier room assignments. Maintain good order, discipline, health, and welfare

**Use resources wisely:** Ensure the effective, efficient, and equitable management and use of unaccompanied housing



- Is DoD's web-based housing management system authorized for use in barracks management
- Ensures equitable barracks room assignments, terminations, furnishings accountability, inspections, utilization, and reporting
- Provides leaders with real-time data on where Soldiers live, occupancy status, maintenance requirements, and inspection history
- Enables leaders to cross-level assets at battalion and brigade levels to ensure equitable distribution across the installation

## What else do I need to know about FSBP 2020?

### **Unit Role:**

- Maintain good order and discipline
- Address maintenance and repair issues
- Participate in partnering sessions
- Execute quarters assignments and terminations
- Conduct inspections
- Account for furnishings
- Maintain accurate records
- Ensure equitable furnishings distribution
- Manage key control and room lock outs
- Supervise common areas

### **Garrison Role:**

- Train, mentor, and partner with unit leaders
- Manage certificates of non-availability
- Ensure program compliance and reporting
- Conduct maintenance and repair
- Perform master planning, annual and long-range work plans and project management
- Perform Installation Status Report services and infrastructure inspections
- Ensure responsible budget stewardship and accountability
